#### 1. INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

Mediterranean climate in the north and the east side, semi-arid interior and the south Sahara. Average temperatures vary between 11.4° C (December) and 29.3° C (July) Rainfall is irregular and concentrated during the cold season (three quarters of the annual total): 800 mm North, South 50-150 mm. Forest cover in the north,

predominantly olive groves in central and Sahel, date palms in the south.

The main rivers: Medjerda and Méliane.

## Currency

The local currency is the Tunisian Dinar TND (1 Euro = 2.3 DT, 1 U.S.D = 1.8 DT). The Visa International is accepted in most banks in Tunisia. It is easy to find distributors in town 24h/24. Traveller's checks are accepted by major banks in major cities of Tunisia.

Tunisian dinars are available: from bank counters at the airport, in the hotel, or in the banks in the city of Tunis or in vending Blue Card / Visa International.

# Language

The official language is Arabic, the other most widely spoken language is French. Many young people speak English.

#### Local time

The Local time: Greenwich Mean Time + 1 (GMT+1).
