- WMO in partnership with African Union organized a meeting of African Ministers Responsible for Meteorology in Africa in Nairobi, April 2010.
- Nairobi Declaration Established the African Ministerial Conference on Meteorology (AMCOMET) as a high-level mechanism for the development of meteorology and its plications in Africa
- AMCOMET endorsed by AU Summit of Heads of State and Governments.

Why AMCOMET

- Impact of the Contribution of Climate Information and services to socio-economic development;
- Need for adequate and accurate and timely weather and climate data and information in order study and understand Climate and Climate Change of the continent;
- This is a critical role of National Weather Services.....to be strengthened.....

- Establishment of Regional Climate Centre in Central Africa;
- Climate Research for Development (CR4D)-Collaborative pan-African platform that mobilizes expertise and resources to facilitate user-inspired climate research to inform policy;
- Development Pilot Project for meteorology's input into the African Space Implementation Plan;
- AMCOMET Secretariat has on-going discussions with EUMETSAT and other partners on Africa transition to METEOSAT Third Generation Satellite(MTG)
