





FOCUS OF ORGANIZATIONS – SDGS/AGENDA 2030









Do you know your regional organizing partner for the Major Group and/or Stakeholder Grouping that you are affiliated to?



DID YOU VOTE TO ELECT YOUR MGOS REGIONAL OP?


Did you vote to elect your Major Group and/or Stakeholder Grouping regional organizing partner?


