6.	Visa	All travellers arriving in Ethiopia should have a valid passport. Nationals from all African countries can receive Visa on Arrival without invitation letters in Ethiopia for a fee of 50 USD, however, Entry VISAS are required for all participants from other parts of the world. Participants travelling on a UNLP or diplomatic passport holders are also entitled to get visa upon arrival.

9.	General information about Ethiopia	Ethiopia has an area of 1,112,000 square metres. Addis Ababa is situated at an altitude of 2,400 metres. The population of Ethiopia is estimated at 80 million and over 50 per cent of the population is under 20 years of age. Ethiopia is a multi-ethnic state with a great variety of spoken languages, the three main being Amharic, Tigrigna and Oromigna. English, French, Italian and Arabic are also spoken, mainly in Addis Ababa. 10.	Weather	The climate is tropical with sometimes very humid conditions, interspersed with semi- arid and dry weather conditions. The weather in October is a little parched with windy. Read more: http://www.addisababa.climatemps.com/october.php#ixzz62c3VZlhc The Daily temperatures in October range between 8-22 Degrees Celsius, participants are therefore encouraged to pack some light but warm clothing for daytime use and warm clothing for the nights.
11.	Currency	Ethiopian currency is denominated in "birr" and "centimes". The exchange rate fluctuates. The official exchange rate of the United Nations was US\$ 1.00 = ETB 29.4860 as of 1st of October 2019. There are ATMs accepting international cards at Bole Airport as well as inside the premises of UN Women Offices. There is a branch of the Commercial Bank of Ethiopia in the ECA compound, in the Rotunda. The bank is open Monday–Friday, from 8 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. There is also an authorized exchange centre (Forex) at the Sheraton Hotel, and ATM machines are easily found around the city.
12.	Meeting Materials	The organizers will send electronic versions of all the relevant working documents in one of the 4 official AU languages (English, French, Arabic and Portuguese) in advance to all confirmed participants. The key documents will also be provided as part of meeting folders upon arrival at the conference venue.
13.	Interpretation	Simultaneous interpretation will be available in all 4 AU languages.
14.	Security and security clearance	There are no major security issues in Addis Ababa. Nevertheless, you are advised to keep minimum security precautions. UN Participants (staff/non-staff/consultants) are required to apply for Security Clearance through Travel Request Information Processing (TRIP) on the designated UNDSS website (www.undss.org) prior to their travel. Non-Staff participants are required to complete a legal waiver form before traveling to be shared by the respective UN Women Offices.
